In Summer 1954, the daily schedule at the Chapel was as follows:

- o 10:30 AM Children's Bible Hour, Monday thru Friday, during July and August
- 8:00 9:15 PM Hymn Singing, Sacred Music, Gospel Messages
- 9:15 10:30PM Special Features, Religious Pictures

The caption read, "Everybody Welcome: Open from 8 to 10:30 every night all summer. Come in at any time. Stay as long as you like. Go when you feel you must." See the whole program online at this link!
